



Wire Wrapping Classes:

The Wire Wrapping class is set up to teach the student how to wire wrap a cabochon. This is a beginner level class. Discussion will cover how to select a cabochon, different types of wire, tools needed, and finishing techniques. The student will be shown how to measure the cabochon to determine the lengths of wire needed, how to lay out the binding wraps, how to fasten the cabochon into the wire wrapped frame, how to create the bail, and how to finish the wrap. The cost of the class is \$15.00. Tools and materials are provided for the class. The class is one three hour session and is given on Tuesday evening from 6:00 to 9:00 PM or Saturday afternoon from 12:00 to 3:00 PM.
