

Secretary's report-Motion by Dave Watson to accept the minutes as printed, was approved.

Treasurer's report-Jerri Heer is out of town, No report was filed.

Show committee-Bill Schmidt submitted an update of where things stand with the show, and what still needs to be done.

Membership-proposed changes to the by-laws regarding membership are as follows:

Section 2: Admission to Membership

Any person who is interested in the purposes and goals of the Society may obtain membership by completing an Application for Membership Form, volunteering to serve on at least one committee, and paying one (1) year's dues. Upon acceptance into the Society by the membership chair, a membership card shall be issued.

### Section 5: Reinstatement

A member suspended for nonpayment of dues by November 30th may be reinstated by filling out a new application, paying their delinquent dues, and sending or giving the application and dues to the membership chairperson for review and approval.

If the suspended member does not submit a completed application and include their dues by September 1, they shall be required to meet the requirements then in force.

By-law changes will be presented to the membership at the January 18th meeting.

The effect of these changes in that membership is suspended if dues are not paid by November 30th. A new application and dues will be required for reinstatement and membership is not reinstated until approved by the membership committee.

Program will be game night.

Audit report-Pat Davis and Joe Cooper did this year's audit report and submitted their report for the board. A copy will be given to the treasurer for the appropriate changes.

Nominating committee this year will be Pat Davis, Joe Cooper, and Sandy Theisz.

Meeting adjourned at 8:05 p.m.
