
Our Show is a three-day event and it takes a lot of people to make it happen. With all the booths and activities we have going on throughout the show there is bound to be something that is fun for everyone.

Display Cases—see what they look like, if you would like to display some of your work sign up on the sheets in the clubhouse.


Yard cleanup is set for Feb 2<sup>nd</sup> we will be cleaning outside in the yard and inside anything that need cleaning.
