Revisions to Bylaws

Section 2: Admission to Membership

Any person who is interested in the purposes and goals of the Society may obtain membership by completing an Application for Membership Form, volunteering to serve on at least one committee, and paying one (1) year's dues. Upon acceptance into the Society by the membership chair, a membership card shall be issued.

Section 5: Reinstatement

A member suspended for nonpayment of dues by November 30th may be reinstated by filling out a new application, paying their delinquent dues, and sending or giving the application and dues to the membership chair-person for review and approval.

If the suspended member does not submit a completed application and include their dues by September 1, they shall be required to meet the requirements then in force.
