Treasurer's report – Jerri Heer presented the treasurers report. A motion by Julia Larson to accept and file for audit was approved.

Show committee – Feb 20 is set for filling the grab bags and the gem mining bags from 10 to 4. The contract for security for the show has been signed and is ready; we still need people to sign up for the different areas of the show. Breezeway – Dave Watson estimates the cost of closing in the breezeway to be less than \$500.00. These are all necessary but we need to determine what we should do first. The decision was made to do the Lapidary Art center first.

Building committee the breezeway has been cleaned out and made ready for the casting room.


