
Yard Sale:

Faceting Classes:

The Faceting Class is set up to teach the student how to facet a gemstone. The student will be familiarized with the Facetron faceting machine. Discussion will cover how to select faceting rough, understanding the refractive index of materials, and selection of designs. The student will be shown how to dop rough for faceting, how to preform rough, and the step by step procedures for grinding and polishing the gemstone. The faceting pattern used in the class is the Standard Round Brilliant. The cost of the class is \$65.00 and the class generally takes from four to six weeks to complete. The class is held on Tuesday evenings from 6:00 to 9:00 PM.
