Cabbing and Dopping

- ♦ Stir the wax well.
- Pick out your stick. You don't need the stick too long, excess length will interfere with your movement on the wheel.
- If you wanted a gridle on your stone and haven't marked it, do this now.
- ♦ Clean / clean-off both your stone and the stick.
- Stir the wax well.
- ♦ Warm the stone while you stir the dopping wax.
- Use ample dop wax to attach your stone.
- Attach and rest the stick and stone on a level surface.
- Set the dopped stone aside so it can harden for use.
- Work on dopping a new cabochon while this one is setting. Or use a dopped cab on a machine... Cut a new slab, or shape a new stone to dop next. Always have multiple projects, so you keep working.
- Put your stone on the dop stick in the freezer, the chill will ease the removal and separation.
- If something isn't working out right for you, set it aside and work on something else.
