We all have saved the SGAMS funds, by converting the newsletter delivery to email. The SGAMS Newsletter delivery was a cost minimum of:

\$0.15 per page, times 8 pages= \$1.20, some printers were \$0.14, for \$1.12 for 1 print.

The postage is now around \$0.50, per person, per mailing, equals a minimum of \$1.62, with the printing.

There are 9 months where the newsletter is produced, September through May.

Therefore 9 x \$1.62 = \$14.58, per person, per year is the savings provided. Now all of that money has since been redirected towards the SGAMS Club. Which means you are truly contributing to the good of the SGAMS Club, each year with your paid Membership.
